

Rules on using cookies

- 1.1 365 is authorised to process, mainly collect, data about the Users of webpages with tools used for automated collection of data, in particular cookies, protocols and other regularly used tools to obtain information via Internet pages.
- 1.2. These collected data may be deleted from a computer and data collection may be deactivated or cancelled. For cancellation or deactivation, please contact Google or Network Advertising Initiative. The mentioned data will again be recorded during a repeated visit of the Internet Pages, unless they are prohibited within the client's web browser.
- 1.3. At the same time, the Bank is entitled to process, mainly to collect, data about connection and computer of the User of its Internet Pages, in particular his/her IP address, browser type and settings, operating system, as well as other parameters related to the User's computer operating system. The mentioned data are used for statistical purposes, for the purposes of control of the correct operation of the Internet Pages and, pursuant to the Act on Personal Data Protection, they are not personal data of data subjects.
- 1.4. Using cookies and permitting them in a web browser is at the discretion of every User. However, we would like to note that if cookies are banned in a web browser, the 365 webpages' functionality can be limited.

About cookies

- 2.1 Cookies – are small data files stored by webpages during browsing in the browser's memory on your device. The structure of a cookie consists of up to 255 characters, so it is not larger than 4 kB of disk space.

Opt-out

3.1 If you do not wish your browser to record cookies used for statistical or advertising purposes, you can ban them directly in your web browser.

3.2. Most internet browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. Instructions to change cookies are in the "Settings" menu of every browser.
